This program is designed for the obstetrician/gynecologist to provide specific information concerning developments in the diagnosis and management of medical, surgical and psychological problems encountered by physicians in their daily care of patients and is open to physicians in all specialties, nurses, medical students and allied health professionals.

OBJECTIVES - *After the program, participants should be able to:*

- State the evaluation process of patients with suspected ectopic pregnancy and discuss the diagnostic criteria needed prior to treatment.
- Review the role of medical management of ectopic pregnancy including the indications, contraindications, side effects, and follow up.
- Discuss the role of surgical management of ectopic pregnancy.
- Define infertility, describe an infertility evaluation and list treatment options.
- List the alternative treatment options when first line therapy fails for endometriosis-pain.
- Explain the role of medical therapy with respect to assisted reproductive technology in endometriosis.
- Define recurrent pregnancy loss and describe an evaluation for recurrent pregnancy loss.
- Discuss the role of flexible office hysteroscopy in a fertility work-up.
- Compare the efficacy of flexible office hysteroscopy with saline infusion sonography.
- Describe the effect of age on ovarian reserve and reproduction.
- State the clinical implications of ovarian reserve testing.
- Describe first trimester screening test characteristics.
- List the new ultrasound markers of DV and TR in the first trimester
- Recognize one fetal anomaly detectable in the first trimester.
